Information Items and Discussion Highlights

Pennoyer Pride featured the students from Art Club and the Champion Boys Volleyball Team.

Dr. Kopta gave an enrollment report and indicated that kindergarten numbers for 2022/23 are very low at this time.

Mrs. Ibrahim highlighted our students' participation in Norridge Kindness Day, the boys volleyball team, and the partnership with the Morton Arboretum and 3rd grade who planted 14 trees around the school this past week.
