December 13, 2023

Tax Levy Hearing

Prior to the regular Board of Education business meeting, the Board held a public hearing on the Final Aggregate Tax Levy. There was not public comment during the hearing.

Information, Discussion Highlights and Public Comment

Pennoyer Pride featured the Pennoyer Boys Soccer Team, the Blue Division Conference Champions.

Pennoyer's current student enrollment is at 440.

Mr. Greenberg's Principal's report featured the upcoming PreK-4th Grade Winter Concert, which is coming up on Thursday, December 21. He also spoke about the positive experience the team leaders and administration had at the SEL conference they attended in November. Also highlighted with the Pennoyer School Christmas tree which features ornaments students have brought from home which are representative of their cultures.

Board Member Maria Salvador shared her experience from the Trip I Conference, where she represented the Board of Education as the Illinois Association of School Board delegate.

Dr. Kopta presented the 2022-2023 school report card data, which can be found here. Pennoyer School received a "Commendable" rating.

The FY23 audit is complete. Pennoyer's financial rating has improved from a 3.0 rating to a 3.45.
