BOARD MEETING BRIEFS

March 9, 2022

Information Items and Discussion Highlights

Pennoyer Pride featured a musical number from Seussical the Musical. The performance is on May 6 & 7 at 6:30pm

Mrs. Ibrahim's principal's report included celebrations of the Pennoyer's 5th Grade D.A.R.E. Graduation, Father Daughter Dance, the School Citizen of the Year, and the new math resources. An update was given on state assessments and the 5 Essentials Survey.

The Facilities Committee recommended to the Board to explore the possibility of a \$4 million referendum to address urgent infrasture, life safety and ADA needs. The Board will explore the tax impact on the community at the April 13 Board meeting.

The Finance Committee presented their 5 year financial plan, which includes a 3% set aside from revenues for the reserve fund which has been spent down over the past 5 years on capital projects.

A draft of the amended FY2022 budget was presented to the Board. There will be a budget hearing and a formal adoption of the budget at the April Board meeting.
