BOARD MEETING BRIEFS

October 12, 2022

Information, Discussion Highlights and Public Comment

Pennoyer Pride featured our students who obtained proficiency in English language skills on the ACCESS assessment and our Principal, Mr. Greenberg for National Principals' Week next week!

District enrollment has increased since last school year and we continue to enroll new students.

The employee health benefits renewal increased by 1.75%, which is an industry low.

There was one FOIA request for this month.

Mr. Greenberg shared with the Board highlights from the 5th grade Camp Edwards trip, the 4th grade's Cook County Farm Bureau's visit, the 3rd grade's ecosystems field trip to the forest preserve and the preschool's scales and tails animal experience.

Mr. Ramirez reported updated the Board on the HVAC project progress. The exhaust vents are being installed this week, the boilers are running. There are still adjustments being made to the system and we are still waiting for AC unit parts.

Dr. Kopta reported on the 4th quarter financial report from FY22. There was a \$546,700 shortfall due to late state and federal payments that were received after July 1 and therefore had to be credited to the FY23 budget.

Dr. Kopta and Board Member Salvador attended the ED-RED kickoff meeting, which focused on school safety initiatives and the non-existent funding for these initiatives at the local, state or federal levels.

Dr. Kopta gave a referendum update on the District's information campaign to the community.
